

## **ADVISORY**

TO : ALL RENEWABLE ENERGY MARKET (REM) PARTICIPANTS

SUBJECT: REGISTRATION OF REM PARTICIPANTS BY 31 MARCH 2021

DATE : APR 22 2021

In connection with the anticipated commercial operations of the RE Market by June 2021, and upon recommendation of the RPS Composite Team, the following advisory is hereby issued.

## For Mandated Participants:

All Mandated Participants in on-grid areas who have yet to register in the REM are deemed registered as "Mandated Participants" by 31 March 2021 (Section 2.1.1.1 of the REM Rules) to supplement the target 100% registration based on readiness criteria for the commercial operation of REM, pursuant to the transitory provisions in REM Rules Clauses 9.2.5.3 and 9.2.5.4 on Registration and Membership in the REM.

Year 2020 is the Compliance Year 1 of the RPS On-Grid Rules. On the other hand, Compliance Year 1 of the RPS Off-Grid Rules is suspended until further notice; the deemed registered status is yet to be made applicable on this case.

## For Mandatory REM Generators:

Only RE Generation Facilities categorized as "Mandatory REM Generators", operating in ongrid areas, that are registered in the REM will be eligible to receive Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) corresponding to their actual energy generation (Section 2.1.2 of the REM Rules).

As such, all entities with RE Generation Facilities categorized as "Mandatory REM Generators", operating in on-grid areas, are mandated to register in the REM.

## For Voluntary REM Generators:

Only RE Generation Facilities categorized as "Voluntary REM Generators", operating in ongrid areas, that are registered in the REM will be eligible to receive Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) corresponding to their actual energy generation (Section 2.1.3 of the REM Rules).

As such, all RE Generation Facilities categorized as "Voluntary REM Generators", operating in on-grid areas, may be registered in the REM by their host Distribution Utilities (DUs).

Please be guided accordingly.
