DOE'S CANTEEN CONCESSIONAIRE TERMS OF REFERENCE (for 2012-2014 service contract)

I. BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVE

The Department of Energy has building space for its canteen located within the DOE premises at the Energy Center, Bonifacio Global City, Taguig City, Metro Manila. The canteen caters to the needs of its employees and their visitors/guests for meals and snacks. As the present concessionaire's term is about to end, the DOE is now inviting bid tenders who are willing to operate the canteen and offer its services.

II. SELECTION GUIDELINES

- The bidders shall be subject to the determination of eligibility screening based on the requirements as set forth in the invitation to bid.
- The DOE Employee Management Committee shall shortlist the eligible bidders based on the following considerations:
 - Facilities and operations staff (chef, waiters, etc.) to be deployed to the DOE Canteen;
 - b) Taste/Quality of Food
 - c) Variety and Nutritional Value of food served
 - d) Quantity and Affordability of food
 - e) Track record/Experience in the food business
 - f) Sanitation
- 3. Each selected bidder shall be required to present, serve and demonstrate its menus for ten (10) working days at the DOE Canteen showcasing their culinary expertise on a rotational basis, the order of which shall be determined by lottery. During the demonstration, bidders shall be required to present and deliver variety of local and international menus on special and regular dishes.
- 4. The DOE employees shall rate/evaluate the bidder each week during the demo of each bidder under the supervision of the Human Resources Management Division (HRMD) in coordination with DOE-Employee Management Committee (DOE-EMC). The criteria for evaluation are the following:
 - a. Variety of menu
 - b. Sanitation
 - Reasonableness of price/Quantity of food served
 - d. Quality of service
 - e. Taste/Quality of Food
- The bidder gaining the most number of votes shall be declared the winning bidder.

III. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

C. FINANCIAL

Net worth of at least one million (1M) or equivalent at the end of the most recent two financial years

IV. COST RESPONSIBILITY
