In deference to its call for comments, the SNAP Group supports the Government and DOE's aspirations for a comprehensive and integrated Energy Resiliency Plan as embodied in the Proposed Department Circular re: Adoption of Resiliency Planning and Program in the Energy Industry to Mitigate Adverse Effects Brought About by Disasters.

As good corporate citizens and energy industry participants, SN Aboitiz Power-Magat, Inc. (SNAP-MI) and SN Aboitiz Power-Benguet, Inc.(SNAP-BI), which owns and operates the 380MW Magat Hydro-Electric Power Plant (HEPP), 105MW Ambuklao HEPP, and 140MW Binga HEPP, have ready and existing plans to protect its Power Assets, the Non-Power Components, i.e., Dams, Spillways, Spillway Gates etc. owned by the Government, and the communities inhabiting the environs including farmers-beneficiaries.
