- 2.1. Local, regional, and international newspapers and broadsheets.
- 2.2. Magazines on various subjects such as business and current affairs, foreign policy, science and technology, energy, history, and other special topics/interests. <sup>3</sup>
- 2.3. Content in foreign languages can be translated primarily, into English or Filipino.
- 3. The Contractor shall provide the DOE access to the back issues of the Content dating back to at least 3 months prior.
- 4. Content is searchable via topic and keywords.
- 5. The Content can be accessed and read on computers, *i.e.*, desktops and laptops, and mobile devices, *i.e.*, phones and tablets. Users who were registered and/or authenticated within the DOE's premises (i.e., Main Office and Field Offices) have unlimited and unrestricted access to the Content for at least two months. Outside the DOE's premises, at least 100 user accounts can have unlimited and unrestricted access to the Content.
  - 5.1. The Content can be accessed on various commonly used browsers, *e.g.*, Edge, Safari, Firefox, and/or Chrome.
  - 5.2. If the Content requires a viewer/reader application to be read or accessed, such application can be downloaded without additional cost to the DOE. The viewer/reader application must be cross-platform compatible, *i.e.*, must run on Windows, macOS, Android, iPadOS.
- 6. The Contractor shall ensure that the Content is made available to the DOE immediately upon their publication/circulation by their respective publishers.
  - 6.1. In the case of local, regional, and international newspapers and broadsheets, the Contractor shall have until 8:00 AM Philippine Standard Time to make the same available to the DOE, otherwise, the Contractor shall be considered in delay.
  - 6.2. Failure of the Contractor to comply with Clause 6.1 above shall be considered a material breach of the Contract and shall be liable for liquidated damages equal to 1/10<sup>th</sup> of 1% of the Contract cost. The DOE need not prove that it has incurred actual damages to be entitled to liquidated damages. Such amount shall be deducted from money due or which may become due to the Contractor, or collected from any securities or warranties posted by the

	1. Onboarding	
	1.1. The Contractor shall assist and support activation and setup of the end-user's accounts.	
	1.2. The Contractor shall orient and train end-users on how to access and view the Content. The orientation and training shall cover topics on end-user account management, navigation, common use cases such as:	
	1.2.1.Reading/Viewing; 1.2.2.Searching for specific Content; 1.2.3.Downloading; 1.2.4.Annotating downloaded items; 1.2.5.Printing downloaded items; and 1.2.6.Fair Use.	
	1.3. The Contractor shall orient and train administrators in administrator account management, generating usage reports, and detecting and mitigating security incidents and abuse (violations of fair use).
