The contractor must provide proposed interior wall, floor and ceiling finishes to check conformity of the proposed material installation and to make the necessary adjustments on the drawings (if any). Additional design requirements shall be referred to the AS-GSD and VFO representatives.</p> <p><i>Clearing Works</i> The project site shall be cleared of debris, dirt and any dismantled materials.
