

CHECK THE WEIGHT OF THE LPG TANK BEFORE BUYING

Always look for the DOE-required weighing scale at LPG stores or outlets.

How do you determine the net content of LPG?



1. Look for the tare weight (weight of the empty tank) of the LPG you're buying.

Tare weight (TW) is indicated on the tank's shoulder.

2. Weigh the filled LPG tank.

3. Deduct the tare weight from the weight of the filled LPG tank.



Example:

Weight of filled LPG Tank	23.3 kg
Tare Weight (TW)	12.3 kg
<hr/>	
Correct net content	11.0 kg*

*Standard weight of LPG for household use is 11.0 kg.
