The following items shall form part of the bidding documents (Terms of Reference):

Contracted Energy (kWh per month or year)	No take-or-pay volume No minimum energy off-take	MEOT has an impact on the proposed rates of the bidders.	Have 75% capacity factor, meaning this is the minimum energy off-take
Replacement Power	Replacement power rate should be equal or lower than the ERC-approved tariff.  Replacement power shall be the responsibility of the Supplier. But, if an outage (scheduled or unscheduled) starts and the Supplier failed to provide the contracted capacity, CAGELCO II shall be allowed to source the replacement power at the expense of the Supplier.	Replacement power should not be lower than ERC- approved rate.  What is the basis of price for the replacement power?	Replacement power rate should be equal to the ERC-approved tariff.  Replacement power shall be the responsibility of the Supplier. But, if an outage (scheduled or unscheduled) starts and the Supplier failed to provide the contracted capacity, CAGELCO II shall be allowed to source the replacement power with WESM price as default rate at the expense of the Supplier.
Regulatory Approvals	The Power Supplier shall make the necessary adjustments in accordance with the directive of the ERC.  Downward adjustment in the rates shall not be a ground for the termination of the contract and the EC should not be made to shoulder the incremental difference. However, the Power Supplier shall exhaust all available remedies to reconsider any decision made
