DEPARTMENT ORDER NO. D02005-12-021

**RECONSTITUTING THE POWER TRACKER-TECHNICAL WORKING
GROUP UNDER DEPARTMENT ORDER NO. 2004-06-008**

WHEREAS, Section 37 of Republic Act No. 9136, or the Electric Power Industry Reform Act of 2001 ("EPIRA"), and Rule 3, Section 1 of its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) mandated the Department of Energy (DOE) to supervise the restructuring of the electricity industry;

WHEREAS, pursuant to this mandate, the DOE initiated the development of a web-based information management system called the "Power Tracker" (PT) and issued Department Order No. 2004-06-008 on 18 June 2004 creating an inter-agency Power Tracker-Technical Working Group (PT-TWG) to ensure a comprehensive, efficient and effective management of tracking activities undertaken by various government agencies in the implementation of the EPIRA and collection of relevant electricity industry data and information in this regard;

WHEREAS, since the issuance of the said Department Order, the Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC) and the DOE signed a Memorandum of Agreement on 14 April 2005 whereby the ERC has been included as a member of the PT-TWG;

WHEREAS, due to the separation and/or resignation of some of the original named members of the PT-TWG from their parent agencies which they represented and with the establishment of the Philippine Electricity Market Corporation (PEMC), there is a need to reconstitute the composition of the PT-TWG to achieve a more responsive information-gathering, monitoring and management of industry data and activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, premises considered, the DOE hereby amends and revises the composition of the PT-TWG as provided in this Department Order.

Section 1. Composition. The PT-TWG shall be composed of the following, provided that, if the named representative resigns or is separated from the parent agency represented, the replacement or substitute or officer-in-charge for the position vacated shall then be deemed the new representative to the PT-TWG without need of amending this Department Order:

SECTION 2. Responsibilities. In addition to the responsibilities outlined in Section 3 of Department Order No. 2004-06-008, the PT-TWG shall ensure the submission of regular reports from their respective agencies on the development and implementation of the system. The reports shall be collated, evaluated and finalized by the PT-TWG for submission to the DOE Secretary, heads of member agencies and the Joint Congressional Power Commission.

SECTION 3. Logistic Support. To ensure full cooperation from the member agencies, technical, logistic and secretariat support to the PT-TWG shall be provided by each agency on an as-needed basis. Each member agency shall be responsible, on rotational basis, for arranging and providing for the requirements of meetings among the PT-TWG.

This Department Order shall take effect immediately and shall continue to take effect unless otherwise revoked by the DOE Secretary.
